Approximately 30 million Americans are affected by COPD, but only 16 million are diagnosed. This debilitating respiratory disease is the sixth leading cause of death in the U.S. and has a significant impact on patients, families and communities.

Despite COPD's prevalence and impact, patients cannot always access the care they need. Awareness challenges, education gaps and barriers to treatment can stand in the way.
